OPERATIVE PART

Considering Banja Luka had overdue payables as at 15 October 2022, and pursuant to Articles 14.06 e), 28, 29.01 c), 31 and 32.01-02 of the Procedural Rules, the CFCB First Chamber hereby decides:

1. To impose a fine of € 10'000 on the Club; and
2. The Club is to pay € 1'000 towards the costs of these proceedings.

Notification of the present Decision

The present Decision is notified to the defendant by fax and email in accordance with Article 33.01 of the Procedural Rules.

The present Decision is communicated for information to the Football Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

Notice as regards the decision with grounds

In accordance with Article 32.02 of the Procedural Rules, the operative part of this Decision shall be followed by the grounds if, within five days following the notification of the operative part, the defendant requests in writing a reasoned decision.

Failure to request such reasoned decision within this five-day deadline will result in this Decision becoming final and binding and the defendant being deemed to have waived its right to file an appeal before the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).
